This one-day event aims to support Parties to the Minamata Convention on Mercury in implementing the obligations of the Convention with a particular focus on Article 8 (emissions). The workshop is supported by the Secretariat of the Minamata Convention on Mercury hosted by the United Nations Environment Programme and funded by the European Union.

The specific objectives are to:

- Support Parties in evaluating emissions from Annex D sources and in developing their control strategies and approaches for sources of mercury emissions listed in Annex D to the Minamata Convention.
- Introduce supplementary training materials on Article 8 requirements and mercury emissions control.
- Discuss potential future capacity-building and technical assistance support for Parties for Article 8.
